

Let's take a look at five earmarks of authentic Christianity, taken from 1 John.

First, an authentic Christian confesses Jesus Christ as Lord. Christianity must begin with a verbal acknowledgment of Jesus Christ as the Lord of your life. The **Bible** says that even the demons believe and tremble. True Christians should be able to say that Jesus Christ is their Lord.

Second, if you are a true Christian, you will be unhappy or miserable when you're sinning. This doesn't mean you will never sin if you are a Christian. But there is a difference between recognizing that we will fail in some way, shape, or form in the future and going on a willful, continual track of sin. If you really are a child of God, you will have a sense of discomfort when you sin, because you know in your heart of hearts that what you are doing is wrong.

Third, an authentic Christian enjoys fellowship with other believers. A true Christian will want to be around other Christians. Those who isolate themselves from other believers do so at their own peril, because the Bible tells us that it is important to get together, encourage one another, and correct one another. After all, why should God go to your house if you won't go to His? A lot of us want all of the fringe benefits of Christianity without applying ourselves.

Fourth, an authentic Christian obeys the commands of Jesus Christ. If you are a true believer, then you will obey the commands of Jesus Christ. I will not deny that the Bible is filled with so-called rules, but their purpose is not to make our lives miserable. Rather, they protect us from potential harm. The person who blatantly and continually breaks the commandments of God simply does not know Him.

Finally, an authentic Christian loves and obeys the Word of God. You cannot effectively live the Christian life without a love for, and obedience to, God's Word. All true disciples of Jesus Christ will be students of Scripture and will walk according to its teaching. This is vital to authentic Christian living, because the Bible is indeed the very textbook of life. Yet so many believers will not read the Bible. They don't realize that success or failure in the Christian life depends on how much of the Bible they get into their hearts and minds on a regular basis. We have to do it.

This is the vision that I have for all of us to truly practice and to realize that we are authentic Disciples of Christ. When the community thinks of Warren United Church of Christ they also think of how grounded, Biblically based, and authentic we are.



Here we are getting ready to celebrate July 4th!!! Our summer is moving right along.


We are really excited





Are you looking for a way to give back to the community? Want to help support WUCC with missions? Maybe you have free time that you'd like to put to good use? Here are a few ways you can reach out to the community or within the church. There are several ways you can contribute to our local Food Pantry. The first is by donating the item of the month. Through the month of July we are collecting Kleenex and Juice Boxes. You can drop them off in the collection bins Sunday morning or in the church office through the week. Another way is by volunteering your time. The Food Pantry is open on Wednesdays from 2-4 and 6-8. Our church is assigned weeks throughout the year to help. Our next scheduled day is August 5th. Lastly, monetary donations are always appreciated. We currently have an active Missions Committee which gives monthly support to the Bread of Life Food Pantry located in Warren as well as the Remnant Ministries located in Huntington. Other local support is given as needs arise. In June the Missions helped with a roof home repair for a local resident. Money collected for this project along with individual donations allowed the missions to give \$3000 to help complete the project. There are also many ways to contribute within the church by helping with the youth, become involved with Sisters In Faith or seeking out a position on a committee.
