To joy or not to joy, that is the question??

I love the season of Fall. It is my most favorite season of the year. I love the colors of Fall, the cooler air, campfires, and pumpkin spice!! The only part of Fall that I don't like is that Winter is close behind. But I try not to let that fact steal my joy. Are there parts of your life that want to steal your joy? We have been studying Philippians and the Apostle Paul had a lot to say about that kind of joy. His letter to the Philippians is often called the "epistle of joy."



The Philippian believers enjoyed a special relationship with Paul and so he wrote them a personal letter expressing his joy and emphasizing the real joy of the Christian life. The words joy or rejoice appear no less than sixteen times in four short chapters, and the pages radiate with this positive message, culminating in Paul's exhortation: "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!" What makes Paul's words even more profound is that he wrote this letter from a roman prison awaiting trial and possible execution-yet the dominate theme of the letter is joy!

Paul was right when he wrote: there is great joy in being used for a mighty purpose. In Christ we all have a purpose in life. That purpose may manifest in different ways, it may result in different careers, but it all comes down to living for Christ. I'm reminded of the old acronym JOY—Jesus, Others, Yourself. If you keep it in that order, your life will overflow with Joy.

This time of the year we its easy to get bogged down with all that life presents to us. Change in weather, holidays coming quickly, maybe its health or money issues. Whatever it maybe in your life, hold onto the joy of the Lord. He wants us to be happy and rejoice in Him. Let go of the past and embrace the future. We can't change the past but the future is what we make of it. Make it the best future you'll ever have.

Being a Christian is like being a pumpkin! God picks you from the patch and brings you in. (John 15:16) Then washes all the dirt off of you. (2 Corinthians 5:17) He opens you up and scoops out all the yucky stuff. He removes the seeds of doubt, hate, greed, etc. (Romans 6:6:) Then He carves you a new smiling face. (Psalm 71:23) And He puts His light inside you to shine for all the world to see.


