

Congratulations to all the youth who participated in the County Fairs and at the State Fair. Great Job and keep up the good work. We were glad to celebrate all of you on August 29th.
















We are barely surviving the heat and humidity of the last few days of Summer and definitely looking forward to the cooler temperatures of Fall!




THE COAT DRIVE DAY IS FAST APPROACHING!


