He managed to get one of the town's leading skeptics to promise him that he would attend church for four Sundays on which Maclaren would be presenting the main ideas of Christianity. The skeptic listened intently to Maclaren's sermons. And after the fourth message he presented, the skeptic accepted Christ into his life.

Maclaren was delighted and could not resist the impulse to ask which of the four sermons brought him to this decision. The skeptic replied, "Your sermons, sir, were helpful, but they were not what finally persuaded me." He said that after church one Sunday as he was helping an elderly lady on a slippery walk, she looked up into his face and said, "I wonder if you know my Savior, Jesus Christ. He is everything in the world to me. I would like you to know him too."

It wasn't the sermon that converted the skeptic. It wasn't the history lessons from Scripture that changed his heart. It was the simple loving witness of an elderly woman.

So, as you witnessed our worship last week, the music, words, celebration, and fellowship; What are you going to do with all of that? Have you, or are you going to share your eyewitness account to anyone? Be Jesus to someone today!!!!

Pastor Troy is preparing for another this Fall. Be sure to check back with us for dates and times.


